How to Build the Paver Pattern Step by Step

This guide walks you through the paver pattern layout only, once the base, panels, and area have been properly prepared according to the Patios4U General Installation Guide.

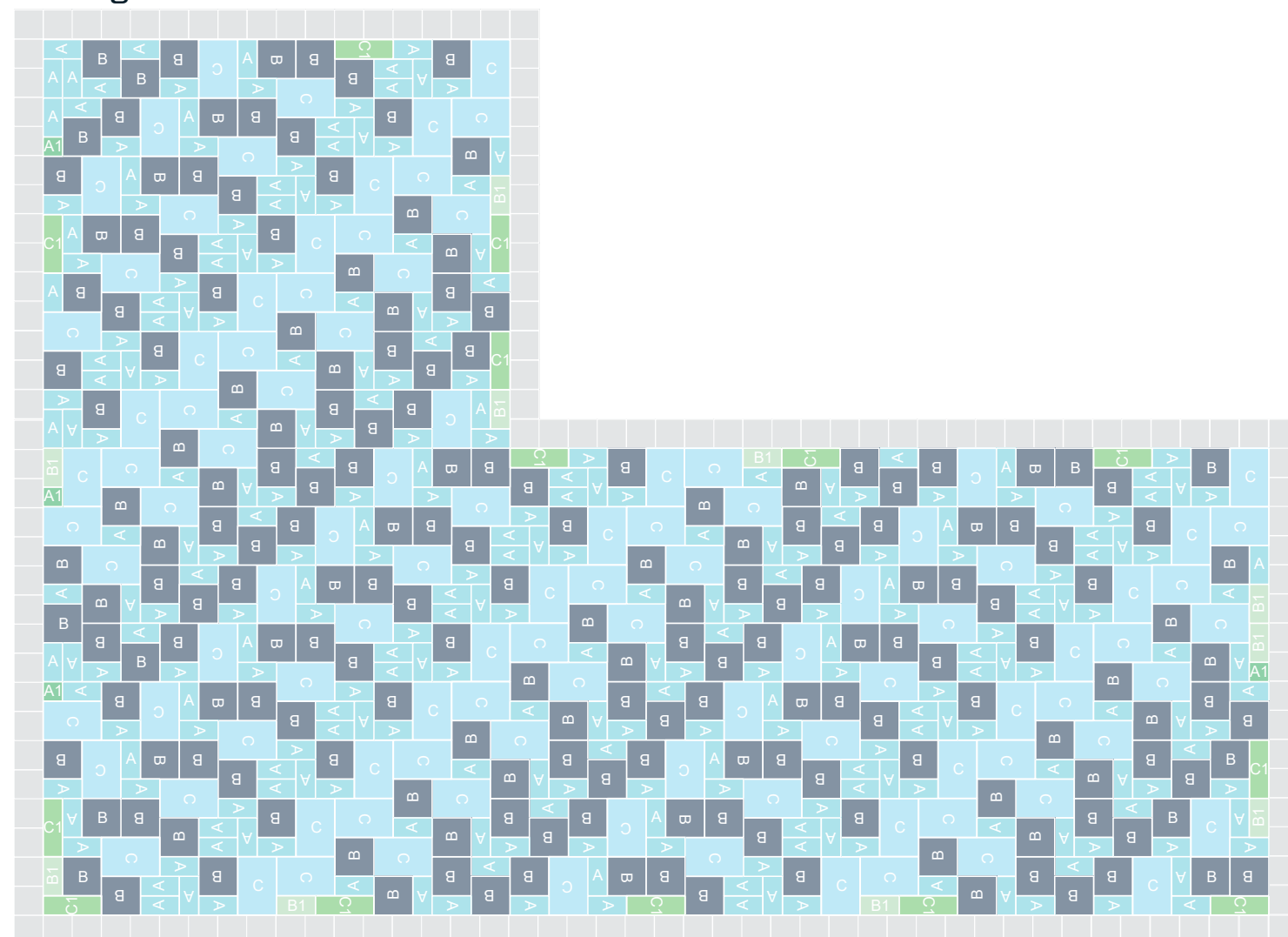
No prior experience is required. Each kit is designed so the pattern assembles as a system, simply by following the correct order.

Pattern Objective

Visually unify two directions of the patio into a single, fluid design.

B:  x10 (5 blocks)

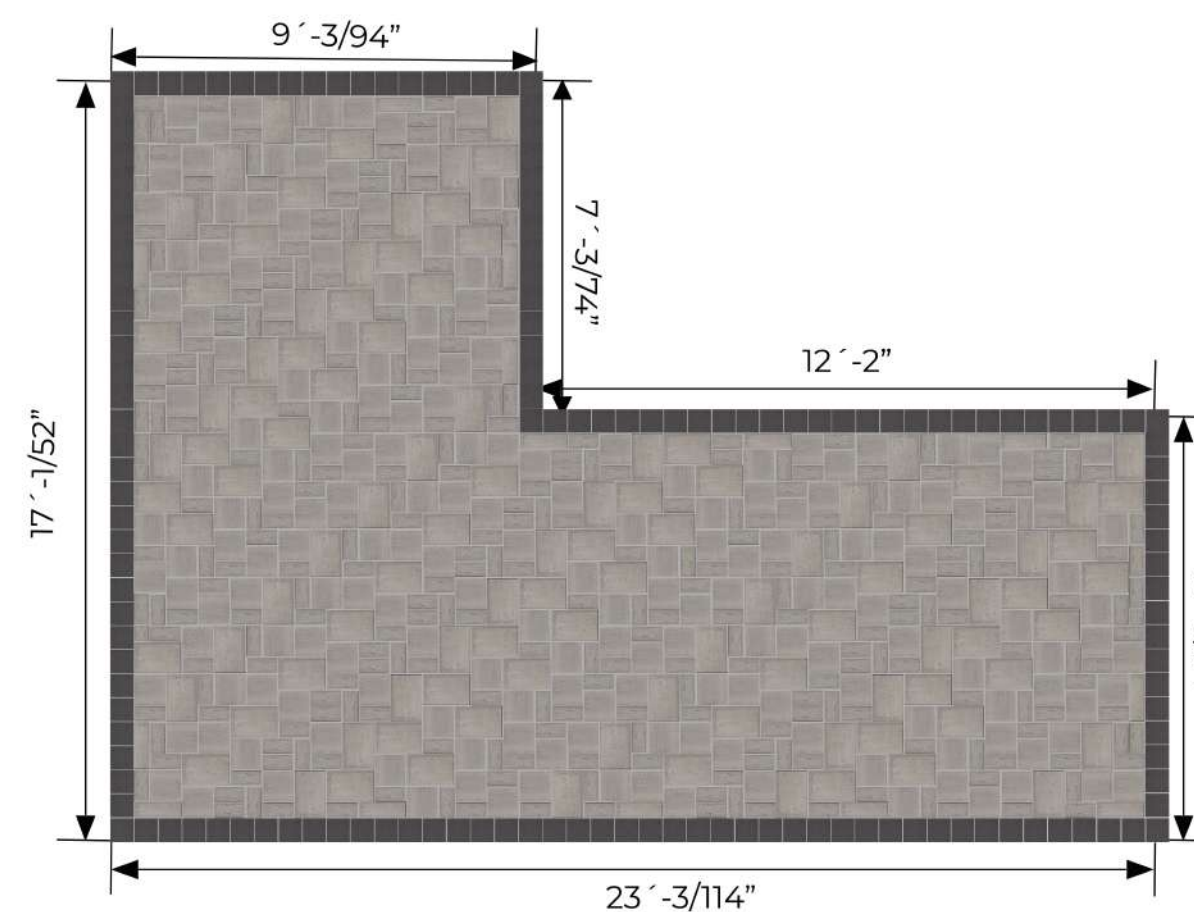
C:  x14 (7 blocks)

C: 106 + 7 cuts

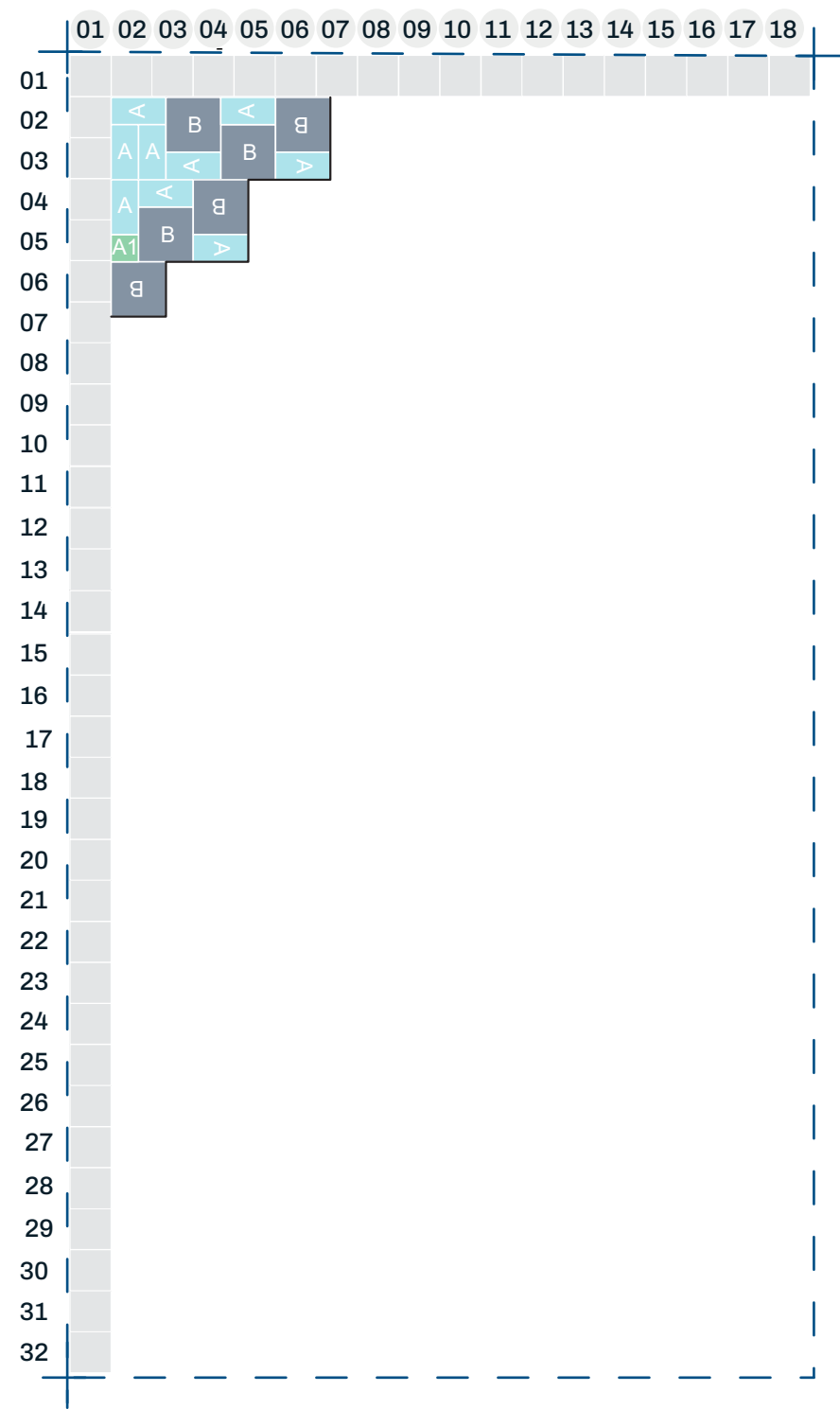


Before You Begin

- Make sure the Gator Base Panels are properly aligned and secure.
- Have the pavers sorted and ready by type (A, B, and C).

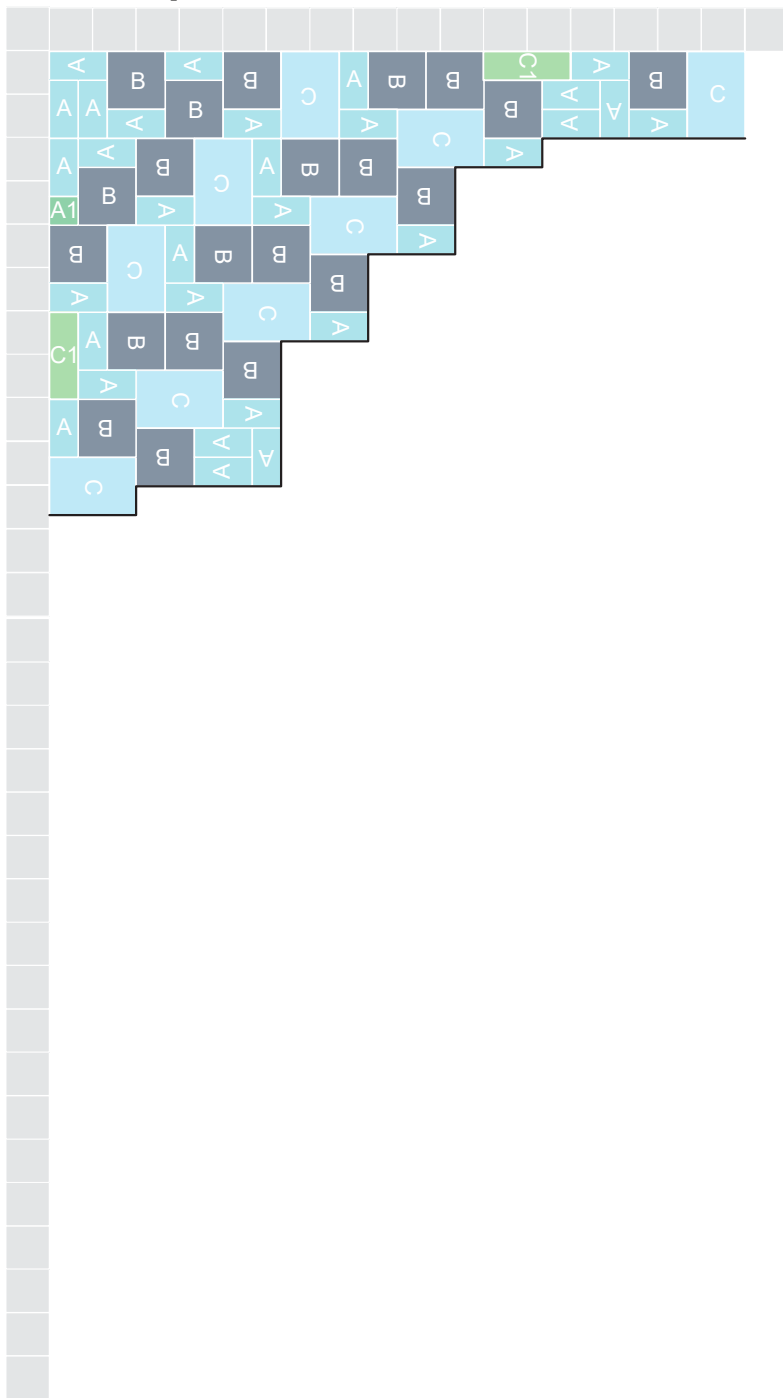
01/ Step:

Starting Border

Mark the area and place the first "L" corner along the house and one side.



02/ Step

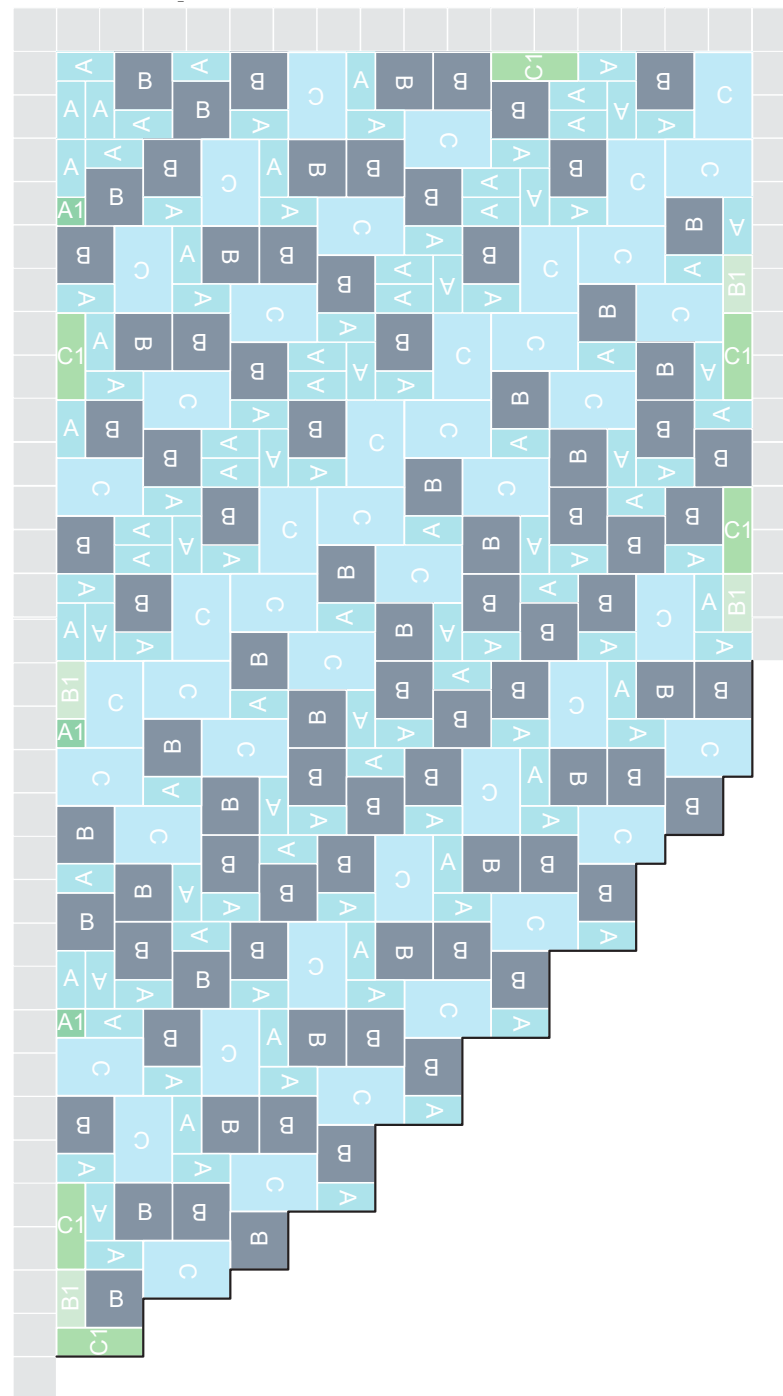


02/ Step:

Diagonal Placement

From the starting corner, lay the blocks diagonally toward the center, integrating the edges as you go.

03/ Step

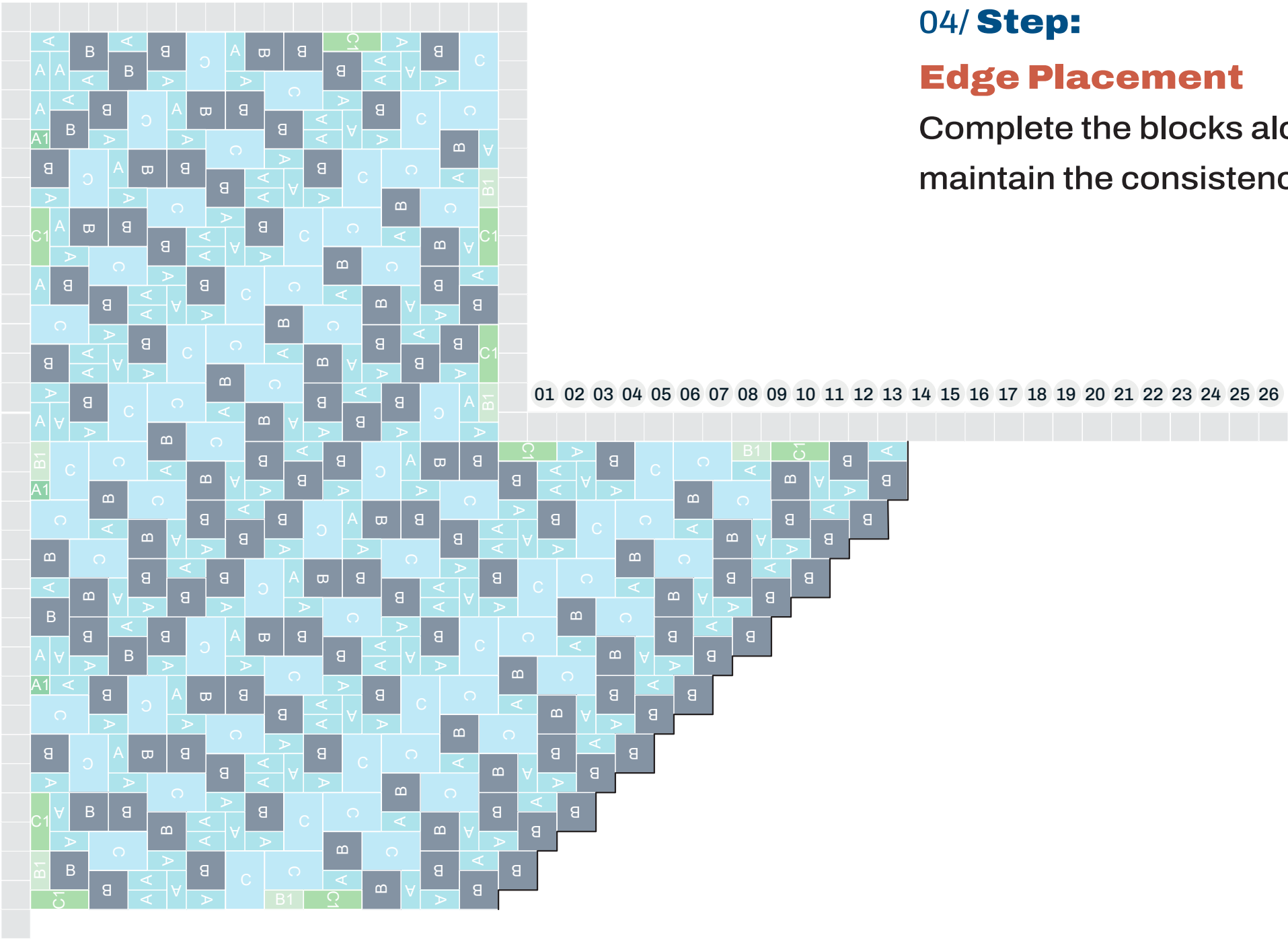


03/ Step:

Expand the Design

Continue filling the patio following the established pattern, covering most of the surface.

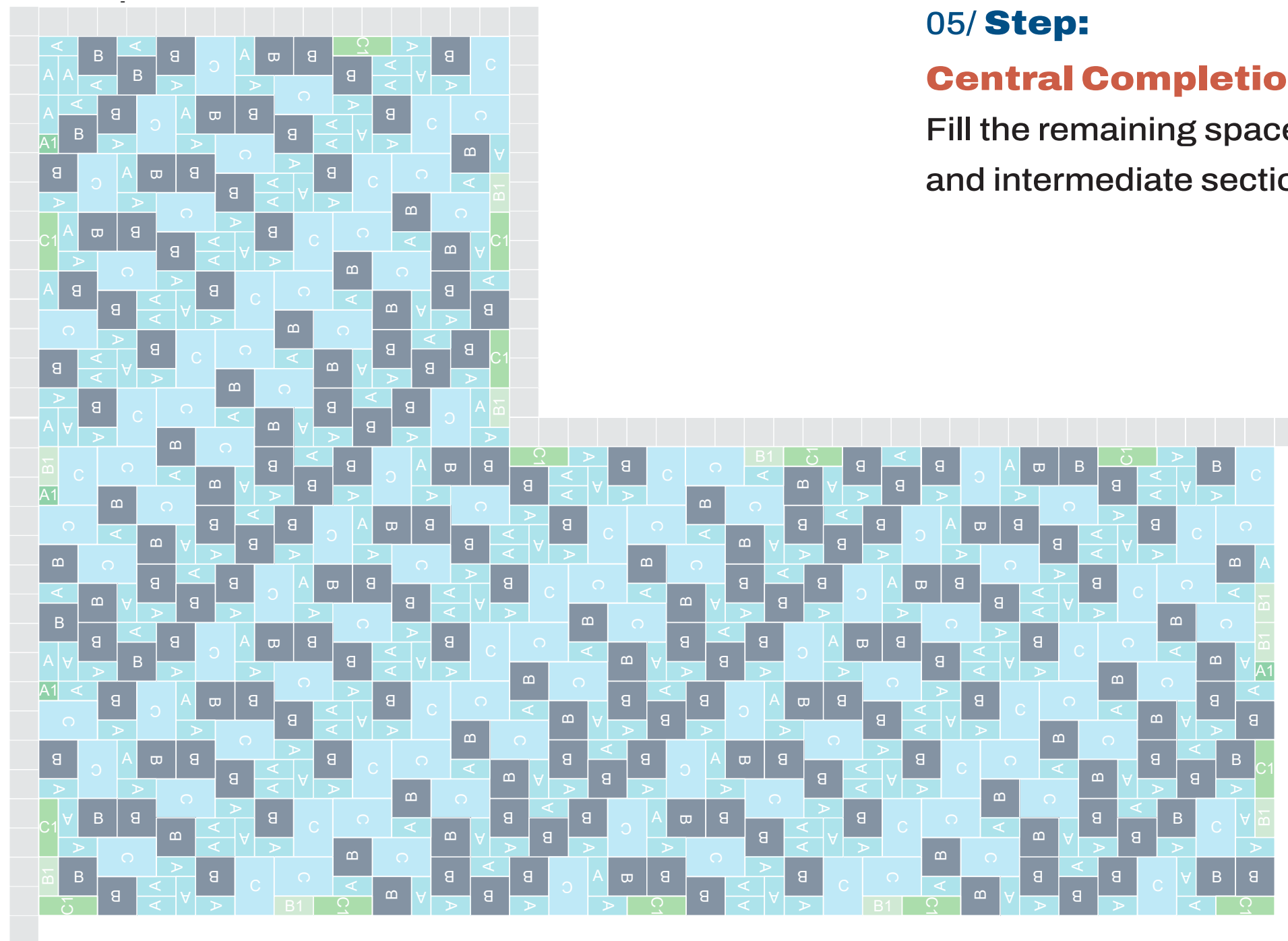
04/ Step:

Edge Placement

Complete the blocks along the edges to maintain the consistency of the pattern.



05/ Step

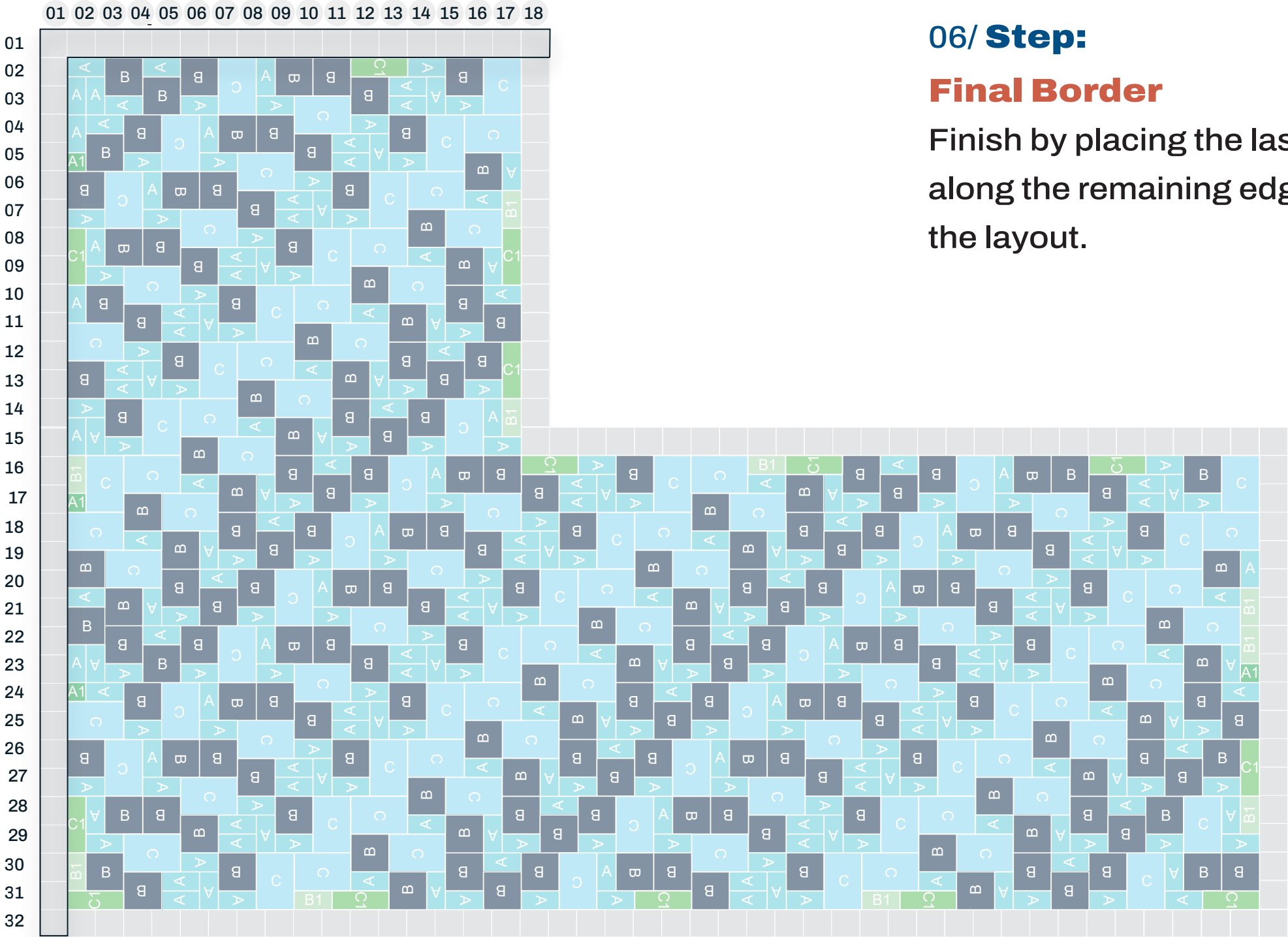


05/ Step:

Central Completion

Fill the remaining spaces in the center and intermediate sections, ensuring uniformity.

06/ Step:

Final Border

Finish by placing the last "L" corner along the remaining edges, completing the layout.
